All Entries Must Be in Possession of the Event Secretary

No Later Than 6:00 pm - (PDT) Wednesday, November 20, 2022

After which time no entries can be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations. Telephone Entries and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical after closing via mail or email. Should acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the event secretary

ENTRY FEES: Separate Fee for Each Dog

NOTE: When a dog is entered in more than one class, the highest price class is considered the first entry. A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog as well as an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Rally Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

FIRST ENTRY of each Dog each day. \$35.00

EACH ADDITIONAL ENTRY of the same dog each day. \$25.00

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

No Set-Ups Allowed the Night Before the Show, Park Gates do not open prior to 6 am.

From the 23 Fwy North bound: Take the Tierra Rejada exit and turn left. Proceed approximately 6.4 miles. Turn right onto Countrywood Drive and proceed to the trial site.

From the 23 Fwy South bound: Take the Tierra Rejada exit and turn right. Proceed approximately 6.4 miles. Turn right onto Countrywood Drive and proceed to the trial site.

•**TRANSFERS** will be allowed at this trial. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned a rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

•**BITCHES IN SEASON** Refund of entry fees for bitches entered in obedience/rally who come in season after the closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening date of the show or given to the Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. The club will retain \$15 for each dog and all other amounts will be returned to the exhibitor.

•Exhibitors are advised to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany the premium list. Rule books may be obtained from A.K.C., online at www.akc.org

•It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

•Declination of Entries. The Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.

•If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management (including weather), it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made

•Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Buenaventura Dog Training Club, Inc, its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation

•There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

•All dogs shall be kept on leash except when performing in the rally or confined in crates

•The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.
